Pursuant to Condition 14 of the Tahmoor SMP approval for Longwall 26 dated 2/3/2011, I have approved the above management plans subject to the following conditions:

1. All risk management measures and procedures as detailed in the management plans listed above must be implemented and fully complied with by the leaseholder;
2. The leaseholder must implement a program to identify, where accessible, by appropriately qualified persons, any buildings, structures and infrastructure within the SMP application area, which are hazardous or are likely to become hazardous due to subsidence arising from extraction of the subject Longwall panel;
3. The leaseholder shall ensure prompt implementation of adequate prevention, mitigation and/or remediation or any other necessary risk control measures/procedures, which are required pre-, during and/or post the approved Longwall mining, where applicable and appropriate, to ensure the safety and serviceability of any buildings, structures and infrastructure within the SMP application area.
