**Re: Tahmoor Colliery Longwall Panel 27 – Variations to Subsidence Monitoring Programme –  
Main Southern Railway and Myrtle Creek Culvert**

I refer to Tahmoor Colliery's proposed variations to the subsidence monitoring programme for Longwall Panel 27, as outlined within a letter from Community Coordinator, Tahmoor Colliery entitled "Tahmoor Colliery Longwall 27 Request to Modify Approved Rail Monitoring Plan" dated 16 September 2013.
