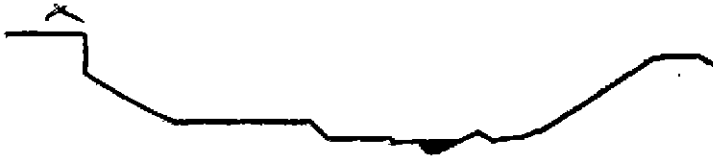

My informant from Pleasant's Nest tells me that "Coombes Sugarloaf" was known to the local Kooris at Bindibong, or Bindibeeny, & the area around the knob was known as Wallamulle. Bindib. Short point: Bony or Bony Hill Wallamulle. Plenty Koori graves. Graves as Masquerade was given this information by his Native guide when they climbed the knob in 1815.
