Summary of Observations, Management Actions and Consultation since start of LW26

Summary of subsidence development

The longwall has completed extraction beneath the township of Tahmoor and is progressing towards Thirlmere.

Active subsidence during this reporting period developed between Hilton Park Road and Bridge Street. Ground surveys indicate that subsidence has developed to normal predicted levels.

Localised increased compressive ground strains had been observed along Tickle Drive during this reporting period. This has resulted in localised impacts on road pavements, services and houses. Additional ground surveys were undertaken to monitor and track changes until the rate of development of subsidence and compressive strain had reduced to very levels.

Natural Features

Summary of any observed/reported impacts or incidents, exceedence of triggers

No impacts observed or reported with respect to natural features.

Summary of Management Actions

Monitoring and inspections are being undertaken as per the Natural Features Management Plan. The longwall has completed extraction beneath Myrtle Creek and is now almost two kilometres away. While valley closure movements have been observed along monitoring lines that cross the creek, no impacts have been observed.

Relative 3D ground surveys of Redbank Creek have commenced. The ability to survey valley closure across the creek has been constrained by refusal by some landowners to provide access. The longwall face is currently directly beneath Redbank Creek. The results indicate that valley closure is developing across the Creek, particularly where the longwall face is closest to the creek at this stage.

Summary of Consultation with Stakeholders

Observations during mining of Longwall 26 reported to TCCC. No issues raised.

Main Southern Railway

Summary of any observed/reported impacts or incidents, exceedence of triggers

The longwall has completed extraction beneath the Main Southern Railway and is moving away. There have been no impacts on the safety or serviceability of the Railway. The railway infrastructure has experienced some impacts as a result of mine subsidence, and these have been successfully managed by ARTC and Tahmoor Colliery.

Summary of Management Actions

Approval has been provided by ARTC and DTIRIS to cease ground surveys along the Railway track, with the exception of monthly surveys inside the Redbank Railway Tunnel.

Summary of Consultation with Stakeholders

Ongoing consultation with ARTC, currently on a monthly basis. Detailed subsidence monitoring reports monthly. Please refer to Railway Status Report for further information.

Local Roads, Bridges and Culverts

Summary of any observed/reported impacts or incidents, exceedence of triggers

A bump developing on Tickle Drive where localised increased compressive strain was measured. The pavement has been repaired by Wollondilly Council.

Summary of Management Actions

Monitoring, inspections and management responses are being undertaken as per the Wollondilly Council Management Plan.

Summary of Consultation with Stakeholders

Detailed subsidence monitoring report is issued to Wollondilly Council each week. Council was also notified of increased ground strains and irregular subsidence profiles and impacts to the road pavement. Approval to cease monitoring of Castlereagh Street Bridge was received on 8 May.
