Longwall South 1A mining update

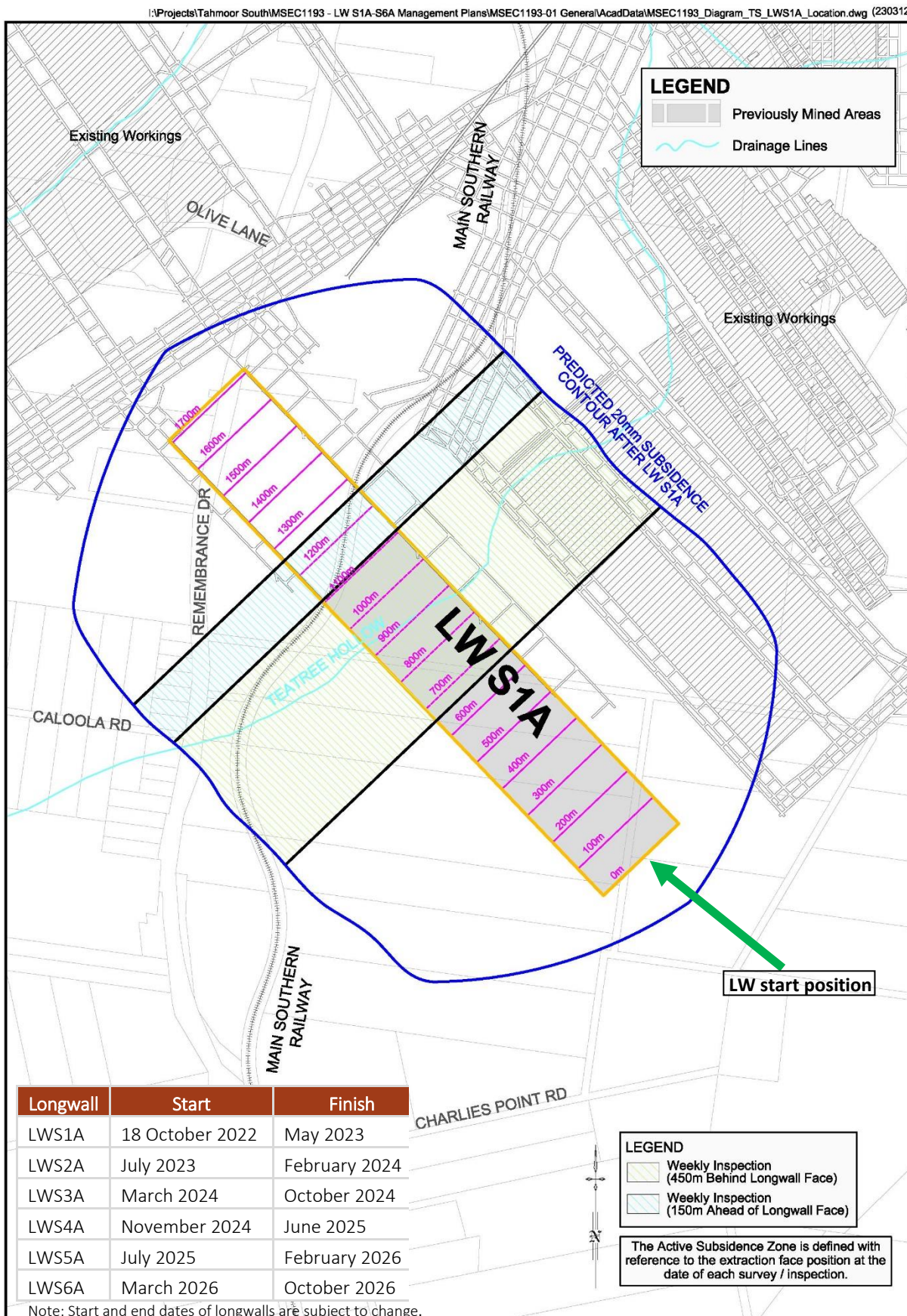


Figure 1 – Longwall South 1A active subsidence zone

Tahmoor Coking Coal commenced mining of Longwall South 1A (LW S1A) on Tuesday 18 October 2022 and has since progressed 1107.5m as of 12 March 2023 (refer to **Figure 1**).

Mining is progressing in a north-westerly direction at a rate of approximately 55m per week and LW S1A is due for completion in May 2023 (subject to change pending operations).

LW S1A will soon be approaching Tahmoor Coking Coal mine site. The predicted maximum total vertical subsidence for LW S1A is 800mm. Subsidence levels are tracking below predictions with 719mm observed in the back-bushland area of the Australian Wildlife Sanctuary. Please note LW S1A does not mine beneath any residential dwellings and there is very minimal to no subsidence predicted for houses.

The commencement of LW S2A is scheduled for July 2023.

Pre-Mining Inspections for Longwall South 4A

Pre-Mining Inspections (PMIs) for properties located above Longwall S4A have now commenced. If you have registered for a PMI but haven't heard from us yet, please be patient and we will contact you over the coming fortnight to schedule your inspection.

Survey marker installation

Installation of survey markers around residential structures and pools have commenced. The purpose of the survey markers is to measure the subsidence occurring at the individual property.

The markers are used to help quantify movements and assist with the assessment of claims if an impact has been visually observed to a building or structure. Markers are placed in discrete locations flush to the ground.

For added peace of mind, we strongly encourage you to register for a PMI and survey marker installation.

- The grey areas in the figure depict areas that have previously been mined in the Tahmoor North area.
