Longwall South 1A mining completed




Figure 1 – Longwall South 1A subsidence zone

Tahmoor Coking Coal commenced mining of Longwall South 1A (LW S1A) on Tuesday 18 October 2022 and ceased extraction on **Tuesday 4 July 2023** at 1711m (see **Figure 1**).

Subsidence survey monitoring will continue for the next four weeks, followed by end of panel inspections by the geotechnical engineers and hydrology consultants.

Longwall South 2A (LW S2A) is scheduled to commence in late July 2023 and is due for completion in February 2024 (timing subject to operations).

LW S2A mining will start from the south-east end of the longwall and will progress in a north-west direction. As the longwall progresses, Tahmoor Coking Coal will be offering weekly precautionary visual inspections during the active subsidence periods for properties containing swimming pools and farm dams.

Pre-Mining Inspections for Longwall South 4A

Pre-Mining Inspections (PMIs) and survey marker installations for properties located above Longwalls S3A and S4A are now being finalised. There are a few properties remaining to register for a PMI and survey marker installation. Please contact us as soon as possible so you don't miss out.

PMIs assist with a smooth claim assessment process should you need to lodge a claim for damage. Survey markers measure subsidence occurring at individual properties and help quantify movements if impacts occur.

- The grey shading depicts the mined area of LW S1A which is now completed.
