PV advised it is very rare that Tahmoor Coal conducts blasting underground and when we do it is minor and localised, 350m to 400m underground. This cannot be heard or felt on the surface. Following the meeting, Tahmoor Coal contacted GM-3 who advised the following information: <i>GM-3 do not have any blast signage related to underground blasting. The blast signage we have on display relates to the current construction of the two ventilation shafts being sunk at Menangle. We've been blasting from about 15m from surface slowly downward. The blast notification board is a condition of our blast management plan as its right next to Menangle Road.
