Tahmoor Coking Coal is continuing reduced operations due to ongoing financial constraints and funding delays. The workforce remain at home on standby on full pay until operations can resume.

Tahmoor Coking Coal is aiming to commence mining of Longwall S4A in early July 2025 (however timing is subject to funding and mine site operation restart).

- The grey shading depicts the previously mined areas.




Figure 1 - Longwall South 4A subsidence zone
